## A SIMPLE COMMENT THAT OBSERVES

The dog looks hungry. Those flowers are really colorful! 1ST PERSON PROBUNS HAT MODEL AN IDEA OR CREATE PARTNERSHIP

*I, me, my, mine We, let's, us, ours* 

Let's go get our bags. We had fun yesterday! The teacher is waiting for us. I wonder if your friend likes pretzels.

WORDS THAT EMPHASIZE

maybe, might perhaps, possibly sometimes, not sure, almost COGNITIVE VERBS & think, hope, remember, & forget, decide, wish, wonder, know, don't know, imagine

## UNCERTAINTY, POSSIBILITY& ALTERNATIVES

Maybe your friend wants to play too. We might go outside later. I'm not sure.

## **OBSERVATIONAL WORDS OR WORDS RELATED TO OUR SENSES**

- notice, see, hear, smell, feel
- I notice everyone is ready for our story.I heard your friend ask you something.I can tell your friend feels happy!

## MINDFUL PACING



- It's really important to give everyone time to think.
- Pause so your learner can respond in their own unique way.
- Don't be afraid of silence!
